- 3. ESSAY: MAXIMUM of three pages: You must use 1-inch margins, 1.5 line spacing, Arial font size 14. Put only the page number in the footer of each page. Do NOT title the pages. Do NOT type or write your name anywhere on the essay pages. There should be NO specific names of ANYONE in or on the essay. Computers and printers are located in the school library as well as Sapulpa Public Library. Use this essay as an opportunity to show your merit and/or your need for this scholarship. The selection committee likes to know how you have spent your time, what your educational plans are, how you plan to pay for your education and what you plan to do with your education. They like to know about jobs held, achievements, weekly hours worked, awards, activities, memberships, community involvement, offices held, etc. Keep your essay to what you feel is most relevant in helping the selection committee evaluate how you spend your time, what your goals are, what financial needs you have in order to accomplish those goals, circumstances affecting your financial need (if any), and what you have personally done to plan for your future. They also like to know about your life goals, what you will do with the education and how it affects the community, how community service, volunteerism and/or leadership will play a role (if applicable), etc.

Students will receive an email upon receipt of application to which a reply will be requested. Failure to reply in a timely manner may disqualify a student from the scholarship so make sure the email address on the application is correct and legible. This must be the STUDENT's email.
